Therefore, to foster public speaking competency of the young minds, an Inter class competition 'Guess who am I?' was organized for students of class 1 and 2 on July 23, 2019. It was an exciting and educational opportunity which encouraged students to explore our past. Students enthusiastically participated and presented few lines on their favourite historical figure in a riddle form. They were judged on the content, pronunciation and their confidence. Space Workshop

In our endeavour to bring the best and the latest information in the world of space, DPS, GBN organised hands-on Astronomy and Space Science workshops in association with SPACE for students of class 3 from July 25 – 31, 2019. Astronauts are confined to limited space, food, water and other resources for a long duration of time. Thus, in the workshop 'The Space Café', the children learned how to design a healthy and nourishing diet to keep the astronauts healthy in space. In yet another exciting workshop, 'What is your Sun sign?' the children were taught the concept of the 12 sun signs, their common name and structure. In the third workshop, 'The Locked Luna' the children were taught about the unique motion of the moon along with its features. Take home kits like Food-O-naut game, Zodiac Wheel, were given to the children at the end of each workshop. These workshops were not only fun, but informative as well, as it opened a whole new world to the children.



Special Week: Science Week

Science helps us to understand the phenomenon of the universe. To create interest and awareness about the same through fun activities, children of classes 1, 2 and 3 observed Science Week from July 22 to July 26, 2019. Students enjoyed visiting the school EVS laboratory, wherein they were shown different apparatuses like the microscope, pipe, petridish and cover slip which are used for scientific experiment. Capillary action activity simplified the understanding of the process of water absorption and distribution in plants. The children enjoyed the Nature walk in the school garden, wherein, they observed various parts of the plants and learned about the process of photosynthesis. In the 'Knowing the Human Body' activity, the children were taught about the parts of the body with the help of a diagrammatic presentation. 'The phases of moon' activity was instrumental in clearing this concept with the help of drawings and interesting videos. All the children participated and perceived the intended meaning and made the week a great success.
