Striding firmly on the path of providing global exposure to the students, DPS Gautam Buddh Nagar flagged off the first **Indo UK Student Exchange Programme** on December 14, 2019. The school welcomed the students and mentors from St Dunstan's College, London under this exchange programme. The delegation from London, comprising of seventeen students and two teachers arrived in New Delhi on December 14 and began their week long sojourn in the country.

The students from London were paired with their buddies from DPS, GBN and they set off for a trip to Agra- the home of one of the world's seven wonders- the Taj Mahal. The students and mentors were formally welcomed in the school by Principal, Ms Indira Kohli with the ceremonial garland of flowers on December 16, 2019. The week- long activity filled Exchange programme comprised Yoga sessions, Sculpture, Art, Music and Dance classes. The British students also attended the academic classes to understand the Indian education. The students were also taken for a visit to Old Delhi, Red Fort, Qutub Minar, Delhi Haat, Akshardham Temple, DLF and GIP Mall.

Finally the programmed ended with a farewell assembly in which the visitors presented the Indian Folk Dance and Choir under the guidance of our dance and music teachers. They were also presented with a memoir of their visit. It was a memorable experience which will motivate where students from both the countries to work together and learn to accept and appreciate the diverse nature of this world- with fast blurring boundaries.
