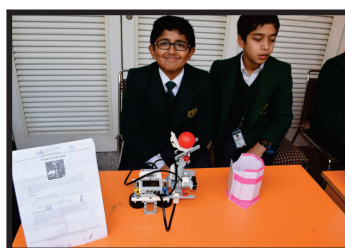
### Techno-Week
