Face to Faith

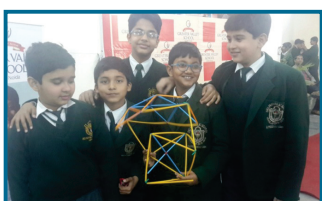
