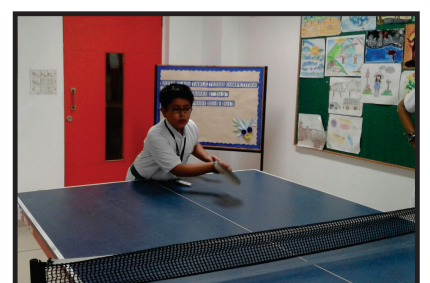


TABLE TENNIS DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP
