'Lending an Ear activity' was conducted to teach children the importance of listening properly. Literary week would have been incomplete without a visit to the library where they were informed about different sections in a library, as well as its rules and regulations. Library Etiquette Activity was followed by 'Train of Words' in which children were asked to write new words they had learnt.
