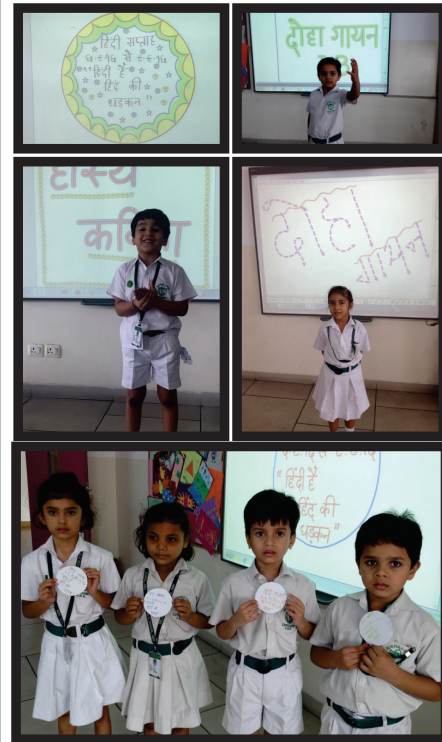
“हिंदी सप्ताह”
