Astronomy Session



On 1st August, 2015 Astronomy Session Level-1 was conducted for the students. The session aimed at understanding science and principles of rocketry. The students were involved in making their own rockets in groups. The students learnt how to launch a hydro rocket. They also learnt about Scaling Down of Solar System, Relative Sizes & Distances in our Solar System. The groups were rated on the distance their rockets covered. It was an interactive session.
