TESTING TIMES...

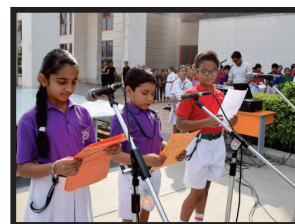
