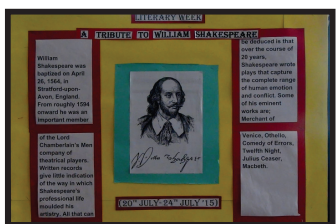

### Vidya Shiksha Kendra

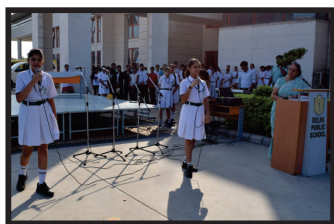

### LITERARY WEEK

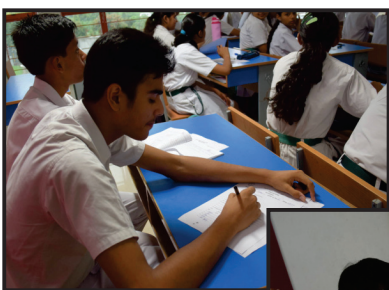


The Literary week for classes 6-10 began from 20<sup>th</sup> July'15 -24<sup>th</sup> July '15. The week long fun filled activities were designed to

### QAP MOCK TEST

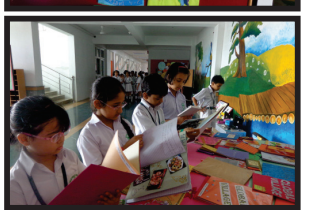
