## REPORT ON TECHNOLOGY - WEEK

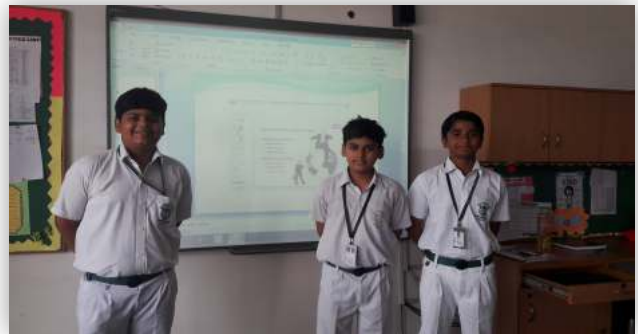
### SWAGATAM, JND
